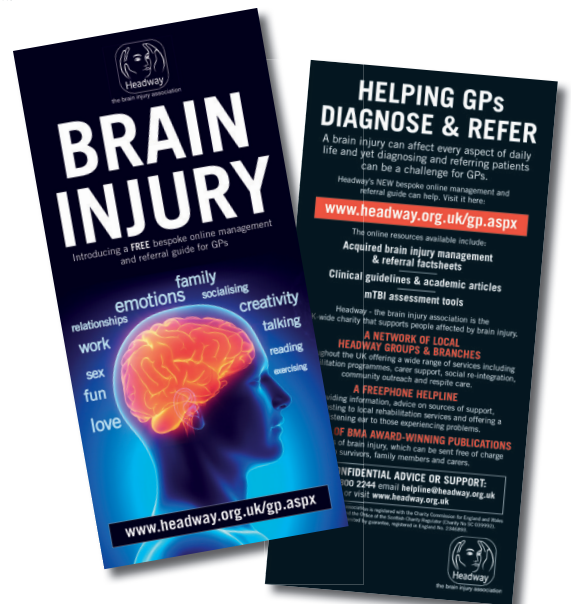
Headway - the brain injury association has launched an online resource to assist GPs with diagnosing, managing and signposting patients and carers affected by brain injury.
