# 12 Miles of Christmas - Raising funds for Headway!

Headway UK have joined forces with Give Penny on their 12 Miles of Christmas campaign, and we'd love you to join us.

#### What is it?

The 12 Miles of Christmas is a FUNdraising experience based on asking people to cover a distance of 12 miles, in any number of creative and festive themed ways, dedicated to Christmas. It's the excuse for people to have a bit of fun in the lead up to Christmas Day and raise money for Headway.

#### When is it?

1st December - 25th December

### What happens next?

When you have confirmed your interest, we will add your group or branch to our campaign page. Following the go live date of 1st November we will then send you the fundraising campaign page information, the fundraising pack and assets to help spread the word and get your supporters geared up to raise money during the month of December. You will then need to share it far and wide and encourage your supporters to cover a distance of 12 miles over December and raise funds for you in any way they decide.

#### Who can take part?

There is no limit to the amount of people who can take part and it is open to everyone. Why not get friends and family involved or your team at work. It really is the more the merrier!

#### How much would it raise?

We're hoping each supporter taking part can raise a minimum of £150.00.

#### What do we need to do?

If you'd like to be part of the team where your supporters can raise money for your local group or branch, please confirm your interest to us by 31st October.



# 12 Miles of Christmas - Raising funds for Headway!

It is important that your supporters select the correct Headway group or branch from the drop-down list on the campaign page to ensure they are fundraising for the right team. At the end of the campaign Headway UK will total up your fundraising and transfer them into your bank account if you are a group and will allocate the funds if you are a branch. If your supporters are not correctly linked to your group or branch the fundraising income will stay with Headway UK. Detailed instructions will be shared with you ahead of go live.

Give Penny is easy to use on average supporters raise 3 x more than on other fundraising platforms. People can choose to donate a fixed amount, pledge per mile or even choose a song to add to the fundraisers play list for during their 12 mile activity.
