

What is an Acquired Brain Injury?

Acquired brain inury refers to any brain injury that has happened since you were born. This includes traumatic brain injury as a result of a head injury which can be caused by an accident on the road, a fall or assault to the head. Other causes of a brain injury include strokes (including haemorrhages caused by ruptured aneurysms), viral infections (e.g. encephalitis and meningitis), brain tumours, and hypoxic/anoxic (lack of oxygen) injuries.

Brain injury affects the whole family not just the person who is injured.
 Brain injury can leave families in need of support around finances, rehabilitation and care.
